


Loading new songs:

- i) First, unplug the power.
- ii) Then connect the USB cable to your computer & the Music Player.
- iii) The Music Player may appear as 'SMPV100' device on your computer, or it may appear as another 'Drive'.
- iii) 'Copy and paste' or 'drag & drop' your MP3 files across from the computer to the Music Players' Drive (i.e. 'SMPV100' or 'Drive K', etc.)

Please note:

- 1. Do not plug in the power cable while the device is connected to a computer.
- 2. Music files will play in the order in which they are added to the player. The Music Plyer does not have a shuffle function.
- 3. There are 40 pre-loaded songs on the smpl Music Player.



Note: depending on the users cognitive level, we recommend 30-40 songs, however the music player memory can hold up to 1,000 songs.
