CONNECTING POWER

Connect the DC plug of the power cord to the **3DC POWER JACK** on the back of the unit and connect the AC plug to a nearby wall outlet.


CONNECTING SHAKER

- 1 Connect the plug of the shaker cord to the SHAKER JACK on the back of the unit.
- **2** Place the shaker under the pillow.



SET CLOCK TIME

- The default time is set to 12:00AM in 12 Hour Time format. (The display will be blinking if the clock time is not set.)
- 1 Press & HOLD 8 [Time] for 2 seconds to enter the Time Setup mode.
- 2 Press 2 [Up/Down] to toggle between 12hr or 24hr formats and press 3 [Time] to make selection.
- While Hour is blinking, Press [Up/Down] to adjust (Press & HOLD to fast adjust) and press [Time] to set. The PM INDICATOR will be on when the time is advanced to the PM time in the 12hr format.
- 4 While Minute is blinking, press 2 [Up/Down] to adjust (Press & HOLD to fast adjust) and press 8 [Time] to set and exit the Time Setup mode.



SET ALARMS




A TO SET AN ALARM:

Alarm Time > Alarm Source > Alarm Sound Volume Default Alarm Time: Alarm 1 - 6:00 AM, Alarm 2 - 7:00 AM

1 Press & HOLD **1** [Alarm 1] for 2 seconds to enter the **ALARM SETUP** mode. Once in the alarm setup mode, the display will start blinking.

2 Set Alarm Time:

While Hour is blinking, press **2** [Up/Down] to adjust (Press & HOLD to fast adjust) and press **10** [Alarm 1] to set. The **ID PM INDICATOR** will be on in the 12hr format when the time is advanced to the PM time. While Minute is blinking, press **2** [Up/Down] to adjust (Press & HOLD to fast adjust) and press (D[Alarm 1] to set.



3 Choose Alarm Source:

Press 2 [Up/Down] to choose alarm source among

(P) Buzzer or (2) FM Radio or (2) Shaker or (1) (2) Buzzer +

Shaker or (2) (2) FM Radio + Shaker. The source you are currently setting will blink.

Press **(1)** [Alarm 1] to exit setting or set the alarm sound volume.

3-1 Set Buzzer or Radio Volume:

Press **2** [Up/Down] to adjust alarm sound volume level between **V5** to **V30** from initial level **V15**.


Press **1** [Alarm 1] to make selection.


(Tuned channel on the radio will be used for the radio alarm.)

4 Once the alarm has been set, the alarm will be ready with the corresponding alarm indicator on.

Note:

Apply same routine to set Alarm 2 with [2 [Alarm 2]] button.





ENABLE/DISABLE ALARM


Please make sure if any of Alarm 1 or Alarm 2 is disabled by turning each one off, specified alarm sound or vibration won't be played at the alarm time. It should be turned on again to be enabled.

Alarms can be **Enabled/Disabled** by pressing **(1)**[Alarm 1] or **12** [Alarm 2].

When $\mathfrak{D}[\mathfrak{A}]$ and/or $\mathfrak{D}[\mathfrak{A}]$ is showing, the alarm is set to **ON** and will activate at the scheduled time. If the indication is not showing, the alarm is set to **OFF**.

Note:

Shaker works only when properly connected to the unit.




SNOOZE/STOP ALARM

1 When the alarm is activated, the corresponding
1 Alarm 1 or
2 Alarm 2 indicator will blink on the display.


Press [1] [Snooze] to temporarily silence the alarm. The alarm will be delayed with 9 minutes interval to be recurred. The corresponding [7] Alarm 1 or [2] Alarm 2 indicator will blink on the display during the snooze period.

3 To **STOP** the alarm completely, press **1** [\bigcirc]. This will stop the alarm until the next alarm time.




SLEEP TIMER FUNCTION

- The Sleep Timer Function allows you to set to stop the FM Radio or Bluetooth after the specified time has elapsed.
- **1** Press **1** [७] to turn on the audio function.
- 2 Press 4 [*] or 6 [FM] to select desired audio source from Bluetooth or FM Radio. (Go to page 16 for Bluetooth and page 14 for FM Radio to refer setup instructions of each.)
- 3 Press 3 [Sleep] to set the sleep timer while Bluetooth audio is playing. Continue to press 3 [Sleep] until reach to the desired timer from 10 to 90 in 10 minutes interval and wait 5 seconds to keep the selected timer: 90 > 80 > > 10 > OFF
- **4** Sleep indicator will be displayed once the sleep timer is set.



- **5** The **Bluetooth** audio or **FM Radio** will be automatically turned off if the set timer expires.
- To check the remaining time until sleep, simply press
 [Sleep]. Timer will be changed to the next timer interval if [Sleep] is pressed again while the remaning time is displayed.
- 7 To turn off the timer, press [Sleep] repeatedly until the value toggles to OFF and wait 5 seconds. 25 SLEEP indicator will be disappeared.






FM RADIO

USING FM RADIO

- 1 Unravel and extend the antenna to improve the FM radio signal reception.
- Press **1** [♠] to turn on the audio function.
- Press **6 [FM]** to select **FM Radio**.
- Press **9** [**I ◄]** or [**▶ I**] to change the FM radio frequency.
- Press & **HOLD 9** [I◄] or [►►I] to automatically scan available channel.
- To turn the FM radio off, press **1** [७].




SETTING FM RADIO PRESETS

- A Preset option is only available when the Radio is on.
- 1 While FM radio is turned on, press ⑨[I◄] or [►►I] to select the desired frequency.
- **2** Press & **HOLD 7** [**Preset**] until the prest number is blinking.
- **3** Toggle through $\mathfrak{g}[\mathbb{I} \triangleleft \mathbb{I}]$ or $[\mathbb{I} \triangleleft \mathbb{I}]$.
- 4 Press **7** [**Preset**] to program the preset with the selected frequency.

USING FM RADIO PRESETS

1 While FM radio is turned on, Press ⑦ [Preset] and press ⑨ [1◄4] or [▶▶1] to change the preset stations:P01 > P02 > ... > P20






BLUETOOTH

PAIRING WITH OTHER DEVICE

- Effective Bluetooth range: 33ft (10m)
- 1 Press ① [♠] to turn on the audio function.
- 2 Press 4 [*] to select Bluetooth.
- 3 If the unit is turned on first time, it will enter the Bluetooth Pairing mode automatically and blink Bluetooth indication.
- **4** Go to settings Bluetooth on your mobile device and turn on Bluetooth. iPhone/iPad will scan devices automatically and press **Scan** on Android devices.
- **5** Tap "iLuv TimeShaker 6Q Wow" from the discovered devices list.





Once two devices are connected successfully, a voice prompt "Bluetooth connected" will be heard and the
 Bluetooth indication stops blinking.

Note:

To enter the paring mode manually, press & **HOLD 4** [*] for 2 seconds after turning on the audio function.

AUTO RECONNECTING


- 1 If the paired mobile device is out of range or disconnected TimeShaker 6Q Wow Bluetooth, the Bluetooth indication will start to blink. In case of out of range, connection will be restored automatically if the pairing device appears in the range again.
- 2 Incase of disconnection or if the connection is not restored automatically, press & HOLD 4[*] for 2 seconds to reconnect or restart paring.





MUSIC PLAYBACK

- 1 Once connected to your device, play a music or audio source on your preferred app.
- 2 Press **⑤** [►II] to play your music.
- 3 Press 5 [►II] to pause while music is playing
- **4** Press **1** [Volume Up/Volume Down] to increase or decrease volume (00-30).
- **5** Press & **HOLD ⑨**[**I**◄] to skip to the previous track.
- 6 Press **9**[**→**1] to skip to the next track.






DISPLAY DIMMER

1 Press **(1)**[Snooze/Dimmer] to adjust the brightness in 11 levels circulating form 100 (maximum) to 00 (dimmed out) by 10.

2 Default brightness level is **100**.



USING QI WIRELESS CHARGING



WIRELESS CHARGE INDICATOR


Wireless Charging Indicator is displayed on the right top corner of the display. Refer to the status indications below:

1 Off: Standby Mode

2 On: Charging

3 Blinking: Abnormal *If the charging indicator blinks:

- Check if your device supports Qi wireless charging
- Place your device in the center of the Wireless charging pad
- Remove any protective cases containing magnets, metal, or materials thicker than 0.12" (3mm)






USB CHARGING PORT

1 To charge other devices such as a smartphone or tablet, connect one end of the USB charging cable (not included) to the 3 USB charging port on the back of the main unit.

2 The TimeShaker 6Q Wow cannot access the content of the connected device.

3 The USB Charging port is compatible to most smart-phones, tablets, portable speakers, wireless headphones, wearables, etc.



BATTERY BACKUP OPERATION



A BACKUP BATTERY WILL NOT OPERATE THE CLOCK

- 1 TimeShaker 6Q Wow is equipped with a memory system that can be powered with two (2) AAA batteies (not included). The power failure protection circuit will not operate unless battery is installed.
- **2** The backup battery will save all previously programmed settings when normal household power is interrupted. The backup battery will not operate the unit's normal functions.
- **3** Normal operation will resume after the power is restored. You will not need to setup the time/alarms/radio if backup battery was installed before the power outage.


INSTALLING THE BATTERY



The back up battery is NOT a secondary source of power. The function acts as a memory saver for your settings in case of a disconnection of power. It is recommended to replace the battery at least once a year.

- 1 Remove the **32 Battery Compartment Cover**.
- **2** Place two (2) AAA batteries (not included) according to the polarity marked inside.
- **3** Place the battery compartment cover to its original position.
